

Directions to Symphony, Amsterdam

Public transport

Take the train to Amsterdam Zuid station. Take the exit Zuid (south). The Symphony building is straight ahead of you. Cross the Gustav Mahlerplein (square) to reach it.

Metro and tram

- Metro line 50 from Amsterdam Sloterdijk in the direction of Gein.
- Metro line 50 from Amsterdam Duivendrecht or Amsterdam ArenA in the direction of Isolatorweg.
- Metro line 51 from Amsterdam Centraal or Amsterdam Amstel in the direction of Westwijk.
- Tram line 5 from Amsterdam Centraal in the direction of Amstelveen Binnenhof.

Car

From the A10 ring road south, take exit S109 Amsterdam RAI

From Utrecht/Amersfoort:

At the end of the exit road turn left (follow the signs WTC). Directly after the first traffic light turn right. This street is called De Boelelaan. Please continue at part 2.

From The Hague/Haarlem:

At the end of the exit road go straight ahead (follow the signs WTC). Directly after the first traffic light turn left. This street is called De Boelelaan. Please continue at part 2.

Part 2

- After approximately 700 meters turn right into the Van Leijenberghlaan.
- After the first traffic light (RBS building) turn left into the Gustav Mahlerlaan.
- You can see the Symphony building on your left hand side.
- Before the Symphony building turn left into the Leo Smitstraat.
- The entrance to the parking garage is on the right.
